II. **Net Abuse**

Spamming

- Sending unsolicited advertising to numerous email addresses or newsgroups and/or generating a significantly higher volume of outgoing email than a normal user. Peaks Media Inc. reserves the right to determine normal use as falling within expected parameters for normal commercial use.

Trolling

- Posting outrageous messages to generate numerous responses.

Mail-bombing

- Sending multiple messages without significant new content to the same user.

Spamming by third parties to promote a website hosted by Peaks Media Inc., using a non-existing email return address on a commercial solicitation, subscribing someone else to a mailing list without that person's permission, cross-posting articles to an excessive number of or to inappropriate newsgroups are in violation of our Terms and Conditions and of certain State/Province laws.
